Applications can be either mailed or dropped off at the Owatonna Police Department, 204 E. Pearl Street, Owatonna, MN 55060 no later than October 22, 2018 by 4:00 p.m. Applications may also be obtained in person at the Owatonna Police Department between 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

The citizen's police academy is scheduled to begin on Monday, October 29, 2018. The academy is tentatively scheduled for eight weeks. The sessions convene every Monday from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. The academy will be held at the Owatonna Police Department. The class is limited to 25 participants. Those not selected will receive notification and may reapply when the next class is offered.
