

ORDINANCE NO. 1597

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 6.2 OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA, AND SECTION 675 OF THE 1992 ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA, VACATING A STREET, ALLEY, OR PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, OR ANY PART THEREOF, HEREIN DESCRIBED, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS RECORDING.

WHEREAS, there has been filed with the City Council a petition to vacate the premises hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on July 23, 2019, on the said petition and after public notice was given, pursuant to Section 6.2 of the Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the proposed vacation does not destroy or interfere with the rights of any person, corporation, or municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that the premises hereinafter described are no longer required for municipal purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That the following described portion of 33rd Avenue SW:

That part of the 66.00 foot easement for Southwest 33rd Avenue established by Township Resolution by the Township of Owatonna dated October 14, 1987, filed December 18, 1987 as Document No. 207189 in the office of the County Recorder, Steele County, Minnesota which lies within the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 107, Range 20 in said Steele County and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 18.

That part of the 66.00 foot easement for Southwest 33rd Avenue established by Township Resolution by the Township of Owatonna dated October 14, 1987, filed December 18, 1987 as Document No. 207189 in the office of the County Recorder, Steele County, Minnesota located within the South Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 107, Range 20 in said Steele County and which lies North of the North line of Southwest 18th Street, as established by said Township Resolution.

may be and hereby is vacated.

SECTION 2. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be filed for record in the offices of the City Clerk and the City Engineer of the City of Owatonna and its title added to Appendix IV of the 1992 Ordinance Code of the City of Owatonna.


