

Chalet COVID-19 Protocols

General Information

- **Chalet currently only open for rentals and take out of food. It is not available for a warming house or to store individual items.**
 - Max of 15 persons can be inside Chalet at a time for rentals or take out of food.
 - There will be a 10-minute limit to be inside the chalet by individuals.
 - There will be additional benches outside chalet to put on skates.
 - Dress warm as chalet is not be available as warming house due to current Governor's Executive Order.
 - Patrons are required to conduct a daily health screening prior to using facility. Any patron not feeling well, has any symptoms of fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, or close contact, or cared for someone with COVID-19 or is running a temperature higher than 100.3, should not participate/enter facility

Arrival/Facility

- East main door will be used for entrance into chalet
- Masks are required for entrance into chalet per Governor's Orders
- Maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet when in chalet
- No equipment/clothing/belongings may be stored in chalet this year
- Drinking fountains will not be available
- Patrons must follow signage/markings for proper use of chalet
- When skating on rinks, practice social distancing

Departure

- South door will be used for exit from the chalet
- Patrons must leave within 10-minute limit and not congregate

Cleaning

- All rental equipment will be sanitized by staff after each use
- Facility seating, high touch areas and restrooms will be sanitized by staff on a frequent basis
- Patrons are recommended to use hand sanitizer or wash their hands on a frequent basis
