

Lake Kohlmier Rental Equipment Rules

{updated as of 05/24/2021}



General Rules For all Rental Equipment:

- A waiver is required to be signed prior to using the equipment. If a waiver is not signed the equipment will not be rented out. No additional riders are allowed to use the rental equipment without having a signed waiver.
- Riders must be at least 18 years of age to use the rental equipment. Any rider under the age of 18 must have a waiver signed by a parent/guardian (must be signed on site). Riders ages 13 & 14 may use rental equipment without an adult with them; however, an adult must be on a separate rental item within 30 feet of riders. Riders under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult using the same equipment.
 - A picture ID is required to be presented at the time of each rental.
- Riders will be instructed on proper use of the rental equipment before use.
- No alcohol use allowed while using the rental equipment.
- Riders must wear all safety equipment associated with the rental equipment at all times, including but inclusive to: lifejacket, helmet and safety vest, and have the safety equipment appropriately fastened.
- Rental equipment and all other associated equipment must be returned to the rental launch location in the same condition as when it was checked out. Riders are responsible for any non-routine wear and tear or damage to the rented equipment or associated equipment. Riders will be billed for any damage at replacement cost.
- Renter is responsible for the condition of all equipment issued, making sure all equipment is returned on time and any fees associated with late returns (a \$20 per hour late fee is charged).
 - Equipment is rented for 1 hour blocks of time. It is the renter's responsibility to keep track of the rental time (trail equipment can be rented for up to 2 hours at a time; water equipment is rented out for 1 hour at a time).
- Renters will follow all applicable Federal, State and City laws, rules, ordinances and policies associated with the equipment and the area the equipment is being used.
- In the case of inclement weather conditions, renters will immediately follow these inclement weather procedures.
 - City employees will blow an air horn 3 times to warn renters of the inclement weather and give notice to return to the launch location.
 - Renters will immediately return to the equipment launch location, secure the equipment (as they are able) and take shelter.
- When finished with equipment, renter will return the equipment back to appropriate launch location, including bringing lifejackets, pedals, safety vests and helmets back to the beach house.

Additional Rules Specific to the Pedigo Electric Assist Trike/Tandem Bike/Tag-a-Long Bike:

- Riders must follow all traffic laws, signs, rules, and regulations while operating the equipment.
- Helmet and safety vest must be worn at all times.
- Electric Assist Trike back basket is for storage use only -- no riders allowed.
- Riders must stay on paved roads, trails and sidewalks, where allowed.
 - Avoid using the following streets: Bridge Street, Hoffman Drive, Cedar Ave, Oak Ave
- Inclement Weather Use: Avoid using during Severe Weather such as thunderstorms, hail, heavy rain, or other weather conditions that may make it unsafe to be outdoors.
- Passenger limit (One helmet and One Safety vest per rider)
 - Electric Assist Trike; Tag-a-Long Bike = 1 person
 - Tandem Bike = 2 people

Additional Rules Specific to Canoes/Kayaks/Paddle Boards/HydroBikes/Peddle Boats:

- No going ashore any place except for rental launch location, unless an emergency exists.
- No swimming from the boats.
- No standing, tipping, or rough play allowed in the boats
- Rental Equipment must stay out of the swim areas marked by buoys and ropes
- Rental Equipment cannot be taken off site.
- Passenger limit (One lifejacket and One paddle per rider)
 - Canoe= 3 with a max weight capacity of 700 pounds
 - Double Kayak; Paddle Boat = 2 people
 - Single Kayak; Paddle Board; HydroBike = 1 person
