DEATH INVESTIGATION UNDERWAY IN OWATONNA

ST. PAUL — The Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) and the Owatonna Police Department are investigating a stabbing incident that happened on Sunday, July 12, at an Owatonna park.

Officers responded to a 9-1-1 call of a stabbing at Dartts Park, 600 Cherry Street Northeast in Owatonna, at 5:17 p.m. Sunday. Officers located an unconscious man on the ground with what appeared to be stab wounds.

Officers and responding Mayo Clinic Ambulance Service EMTs and air ambulance personnel provided medical aid but the man was pronounced deceased at the scene. He has been taken to the Southern Minnesota Regional Medical Examiner's Office for identification and autopsy.

Investigators are asking any members of the public who witnessed or have information about the incident to contact the Owatonna Police Department at 507-444-3800 or dial 911.

BCA crime scene personnel recovered two knives at the scene.

The Steele County Sheriff's Office, Minnesota State Patrol and Mayo Clinic Ambulance Service provided assistance at the scene. This remains an ongoing investigation. Further information will be released as the investigation progresses. The name of the deceased will be released once the preliminary autopsy and family notifications have taken place.
